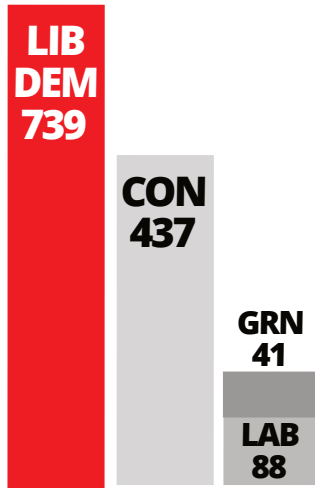


YOUR CHOICE FOR OUR AREA
